

Carine Netball Club Umpire Fees Policy - 2017

Manager's Responsibility

Each Manager of a Carine Netball Club team will be provided with Umpire Funds at the beginning of each season either in cash or cheque. The umpire fees have been paid by each player and each team will receive the fees paid multiplied by the number of players.

Where 9 Players = $9 \times \$50 = \450.00

***Umpire fees vary depending on age group and expected fees this is for illustration purposes only*

The fees provided are calculated for anticipated fees for the current season based on the information available at the time of registration. This is subject to change.

Therefore, fees provided may/may not be enough to cover the fees required for the current season.

Payment to Umpires

It is the Manager's responsibility to ensure that they pay the umpire PRIOR to the beginning of each match on match day.

Where:

Fees provided to a team are **insufficient** to cover the season Umpire Payments:

- You will be required to collect additional funds from each of your players to ensure that umpires continue to be paid each week the amount they are entitled.

Where:

There are **excess** remaining fees (over allocation of Umpire funds):

- Carine Netball Club committee wishes to ensure that ALL remaining funds are spent/returned/provided as a gift to coach/manager or any other agreed arrangement however;
- Any agreement MUST be made by general consensus of ALL players and/or their parents.

Umpire Fees for Finals:

- Umpire funds provided are NOT expected to cover finals. Should your team make the finals you may be required to collect additional funds from each of your players.
